Compulsory national service and/or short stays such as holidays are not taken into account. In addition, candidates must have a minimum of 4 years' research experience in an Institute of Higher Education/Research Organisation including their PhD research but not more than 10 years' experience.

The salary for this post will be paid in UK Pounds Sterling equivalent to €70,000 per annum. In addition, the successful applicant will receive a monthly mobility allowance in UK Pounds Sterling equivalent to the approximate value of €941 (single) and €1,344 (family) per month.
